## DEFINITION OF TERMS

<b><u>Aged Person</u></b>	Refers to any person, who has, according to the Social Assistance Act, 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004) attained the prescribed age in accordance to Sections 10 (a) or (b) to qualify for old age grant.
<b><u>Beneficiary</u></b>	Refers to any person who receives social assistance in terms of Sections 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 or 13 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004).
<b><u>Care Dependency Grant</u></b>	A person is, subject to section 5 and 7 of the Social Assistance Act No.13 of 2004, eligible for a care dependency grant if he or she is a parent, primary caregiver or a foster parent of a child who requires and receives permanent care or support services due to his or her (physical or mental) disability.
<b><u>Care Dependent Child</u></b>	Refers to a child under the age of 18 years who require and receives permanent home care due to his or her severe mental or physical disability.
<b><u>Child</u></b>	Refers to any person under the age of 18 years.
<b><u>Child Grant</u></b>	Refers to Child Support Grant, Care Dependency Grant, and Foster Child Grant.
<b><u>Child Support Grant</u></b>	Refers to a grant paid to a primary caregiver of a child who satisfies the criteria in terms of Section 6 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004).
<b><u>Disability Grant</u></b>	Refers to a grant paid to a disabled person in terms of Section 9 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004).
<b><u>Foster Child Grant</u></b>	Refers to a grant paid to a foster parent in terms of Section 8 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004).
<b><u>Foster Child</u></b>	Refers to any child who has been placed in the custody of a foster parent in terms of the Children Act No. 38 of 2005 or Section 290 of the Criminal Procedure Act of 1977 (Act No 51 of 1977).
<b><u>Foster Parent</u></b>	In terms of the Children's Act No.38 of 2005, foster parent means a person who has foster care of a child by order of the children's court and includes an active member of an organization operating a cluster foster care scheme and who has been assigned responsibility for the foster care of a child.
<b><u>Grant in Aid</u></b>	Refers to a grant paid to a person who satisfies the criteria in terms of Section 12 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004).
<b><u>Grant recipient</u></b>	Refers to an adult who receives grant in respect of him or herself or behalf of a beneficiary or child. In the case of a child grant, and he or she will be a parent/legal guardian, foster parent or caregiver.
<b><u>New Applications</u></b>	New applications are a new social grants added by an existing beneficiary and a new application by a person not previously on Socpen.
<b><u>Older Person</u></b>	Refers to any person who has, according to the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004) attained the prescribed age in accordance to Sections 10 (a) or (b).
<b><u>Old Age Grant</u></b>	Refers to a social grant paid to an aged person in terms of Section 10 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (No 13 of 2004).
<b><u>Parent</u></b>	In terms of the Children's Act of 2004 in relation to a child includes the adoptive parent of a child but excludes the biological father of a child conceived through the rape or incest with the child's mother, a gamete donor or a parent who's parental rights and responsibilities have been terminated.
<b><u>Social Grant</u></b>	Refers to an Old Age Grant, Disability Grant, War Veteran's Grant, Grant in Aid, Care Dependency Grant, Foster Child Grant and Child Support Grant.
<b><u>War Veteran Grant</u></b>	Refers to a grant paid to a person who satisfies the criteria in terms of Section 11 of the Social Assistance Act of 2004 (Act No 13 of 2004).

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## 1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### 1.1 INTRODUCTION

This report presents the status on social assistance end of October 2022.

### 1.2 PURPOSE

To report on the status of social assistance as at the end of October 2022.

### 1.3 OBJECTIVES

This report serves to:

- 1.3.1 Inform management about the status of social assistance as at October 2022.
- 1.3.2 Guide management on areas for improvement in social assistance.

### 1.4. FINDINGS

- 1.4.1. At the end of October 2022, there were 18 904 578 social grants paid to 11 738 316 beneficiaries. The take up of social grants in October 2022 increased by 0.33% and quarter 3 target of 18 846 650 was already achieved in the first month.
- 1.4.2. Foster Care, Grant in Aid and Old Age grants take up have increased by 0.93%, 1.56% and 0.32% respectively and had achieved their respective quarter 3 targets of 222 066, 286 896 and 3 809 815. Care Dependency, Child Support and Disability grants had increased by 0.73%, 0.25% and 0.80% respectively. Disability grants achieve the quarter 3 targets of 1 048 517 while Care Dependency and Child Support grants are still to reach their respective targets of 157 511 and 13 321 827 by end of quarter 3. War Veteran Grant decreased by 5% and had reached the quarter 3 target of 18.
- 1.4.3. In October 2022, 820 347 Permanent Disability Grants and 231 849 Temporary Disability Grants were paid. Permanent Disability and Temporary Disability grants increased by 0.18% and 3.04% from September 2022.
- 1.4.4. The number of children 0-1 accessing social grants increased by 10 337 in October 2022. The Annual Performance Plan (APP) target of 65% of eligible children 0-1 in receipt of social grants, was exceeded with 70.76% of eligible children below the age of 1 receiving children's grants, an increase of 1.9% from September 2022. In terms of the poverty target of 70% of eligible children in receipt of social grants, there were only 66.2% of the eligible children being in payment.
- 1.4.5. During this period, the take up of eligible children below the age of 1 in the Western Cape was 39.3%, and 55.9% in Gauteng. Limpopo had the highest take up of 85.8%, Mpumalanga (78.7%), Eastern Cape (75.7%), Free State (75.3%) and Kwa- Zulu Natal (74.9%). North West and Northern Cape had a take up of 72.8% and 72.6% for eligible children below the age of 1.

- 1.4.6. There were 21 861 of extended CSG in payment (CSG Top Up for Orphans) by the end of October and target of 114 720 is still to be reached by end of quarter 3. The take up of the extended CSG increased by 32.6% from September 2022.
- 1.4.7. The number of new applications at the end of October 2022 was 165 883, an increase of 2.8% from September 2022. During October 2022, 90.31% of the new face to face applications were processed within 5 days and 95.31% within 10 days, an increase of 1.7% and 0.7% respectively from September 2022. In all Regions, over 76% of new applications were processed within 5 days and above 90% of new applications were processed within 10 days. The target of 95% for new applications that were processed within 5 days is yet to be reached by the end of quarter 3. In October 2022 there were 595 online applications and 96.97% of the applications were processed within 10 days, achieving the target.
- 1.4.8. The trend in the payment methods for the October 2022 pay run, showed an increase in the number of beneficiaries paid by Grindrod of 3 201, a decrease by SAPO of 76 836 beneficiaries, and an increase by banks of 104 685 beneficiaries.
- 1.4.9 There were 5066 expired Foster Child Grants court orders as at the end of this period.

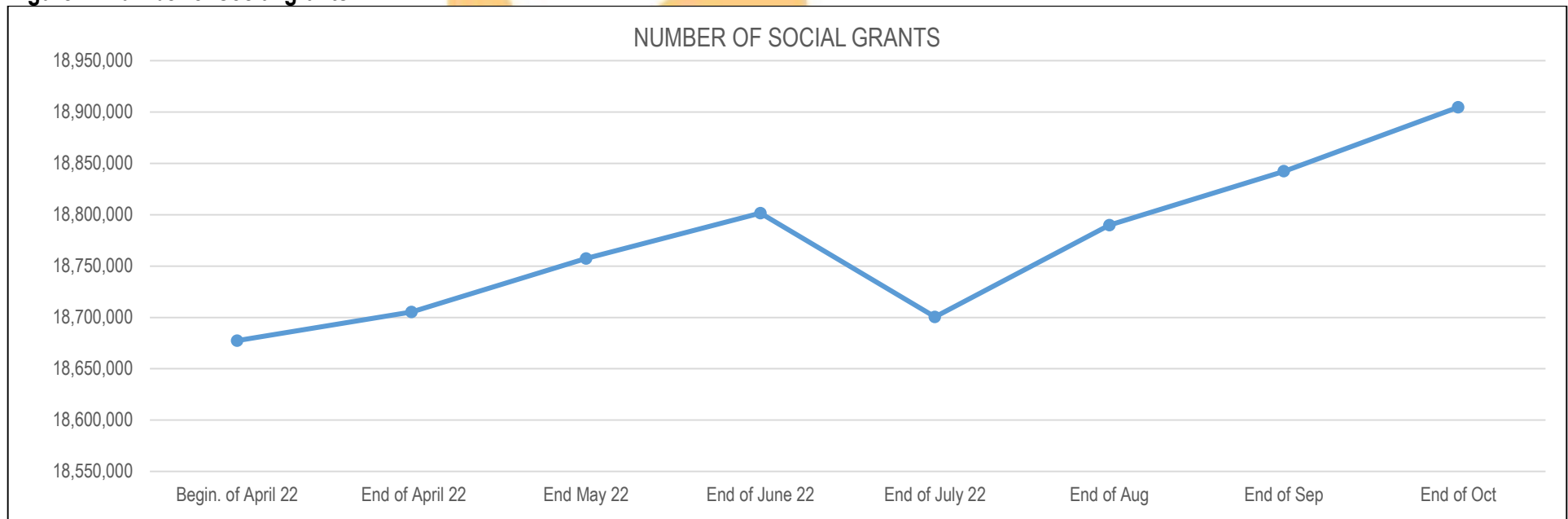

Figure 1: Number of social grants



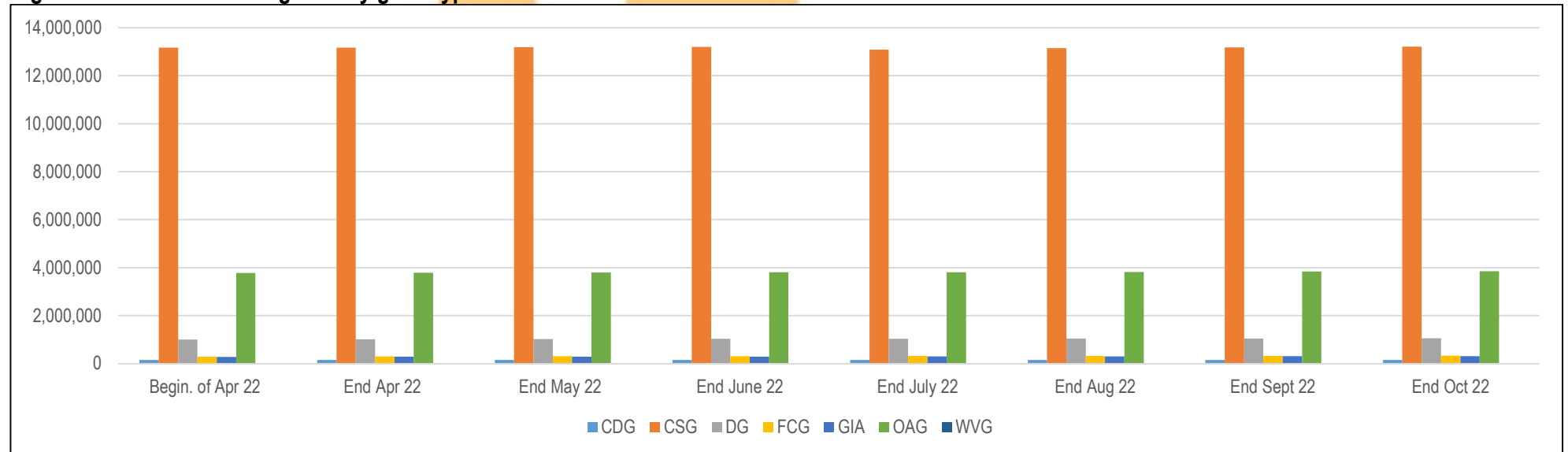

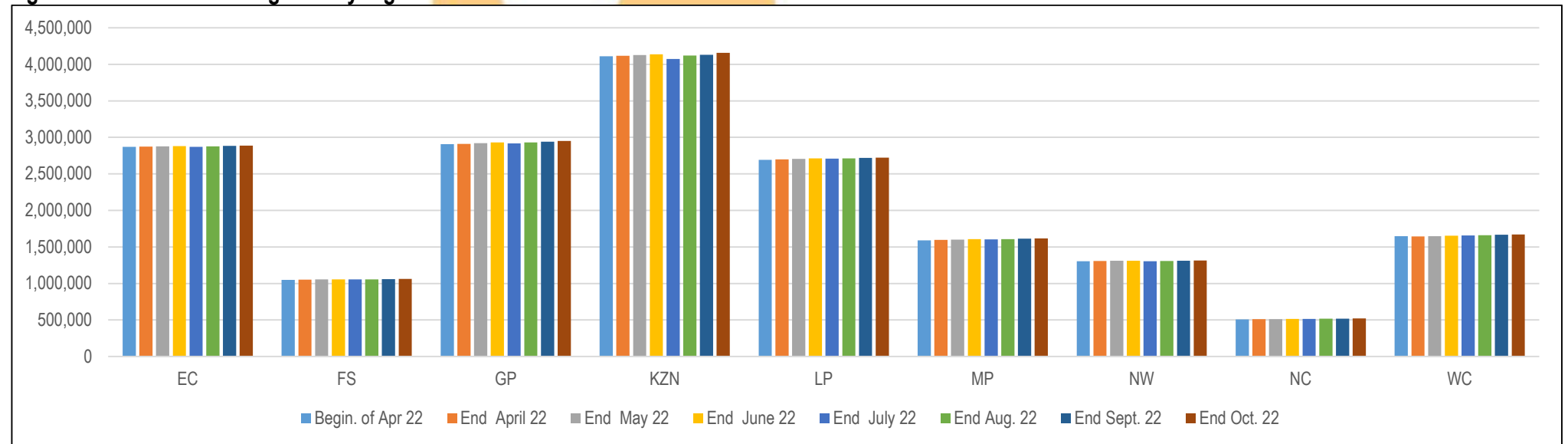
**Figure 2: Number of social grants by grant type**

**Figure 3: Number of social grants by region**

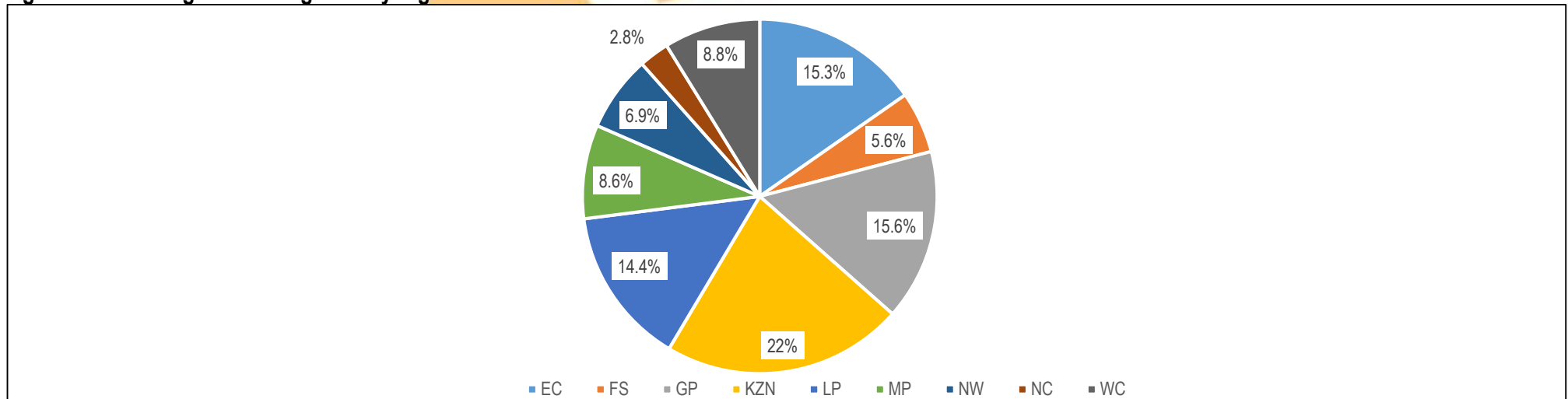

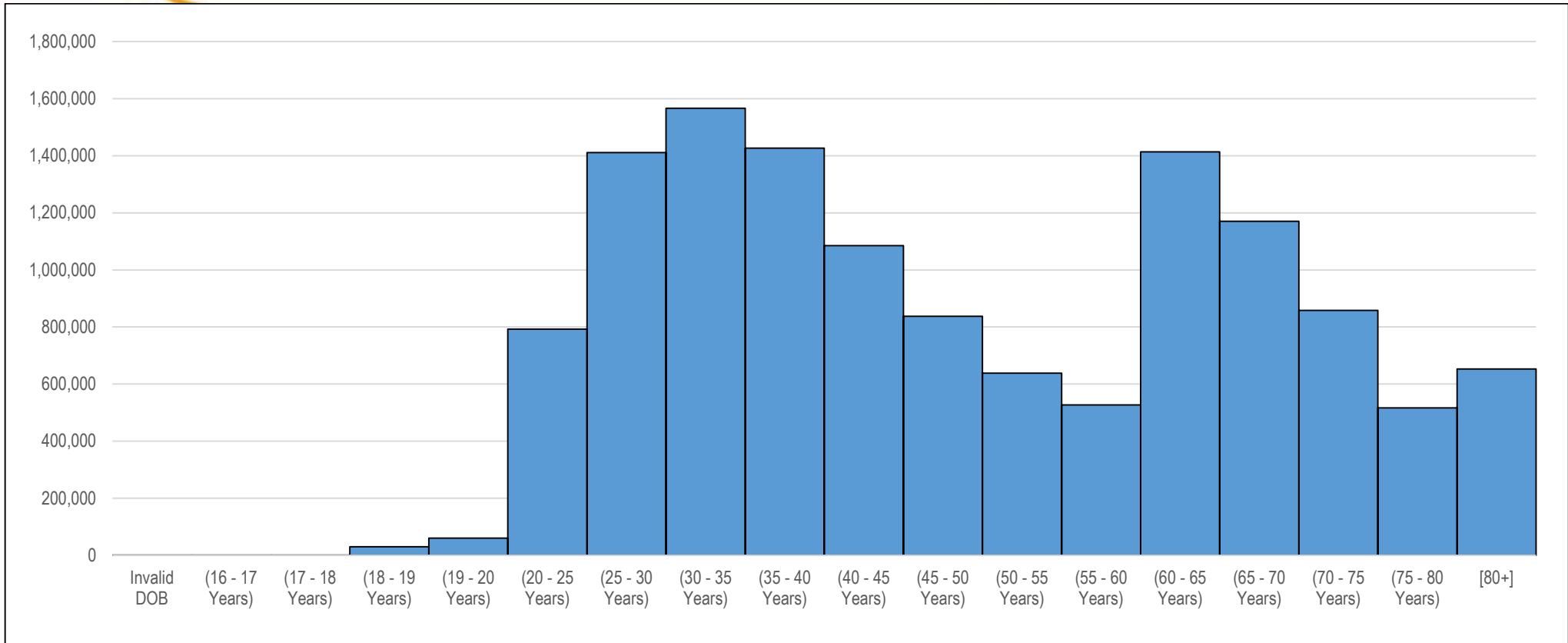

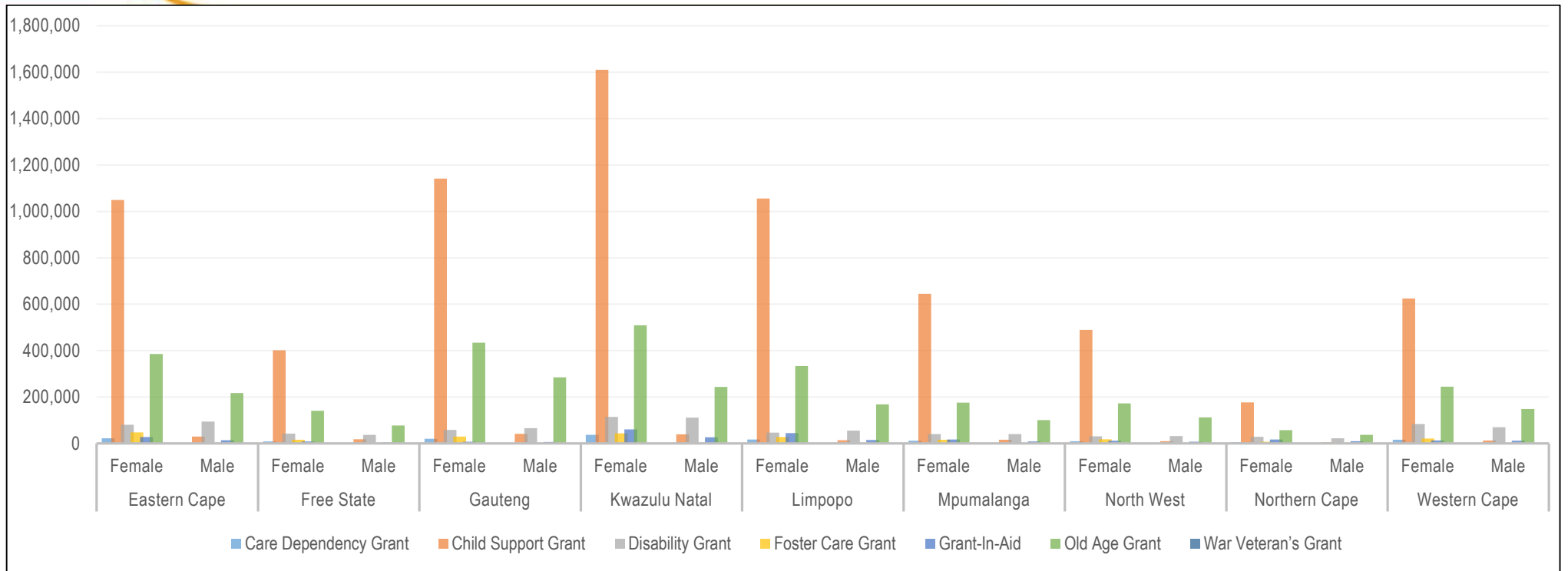

Figure 8: Number of beneficiaries by grant type, region and gender

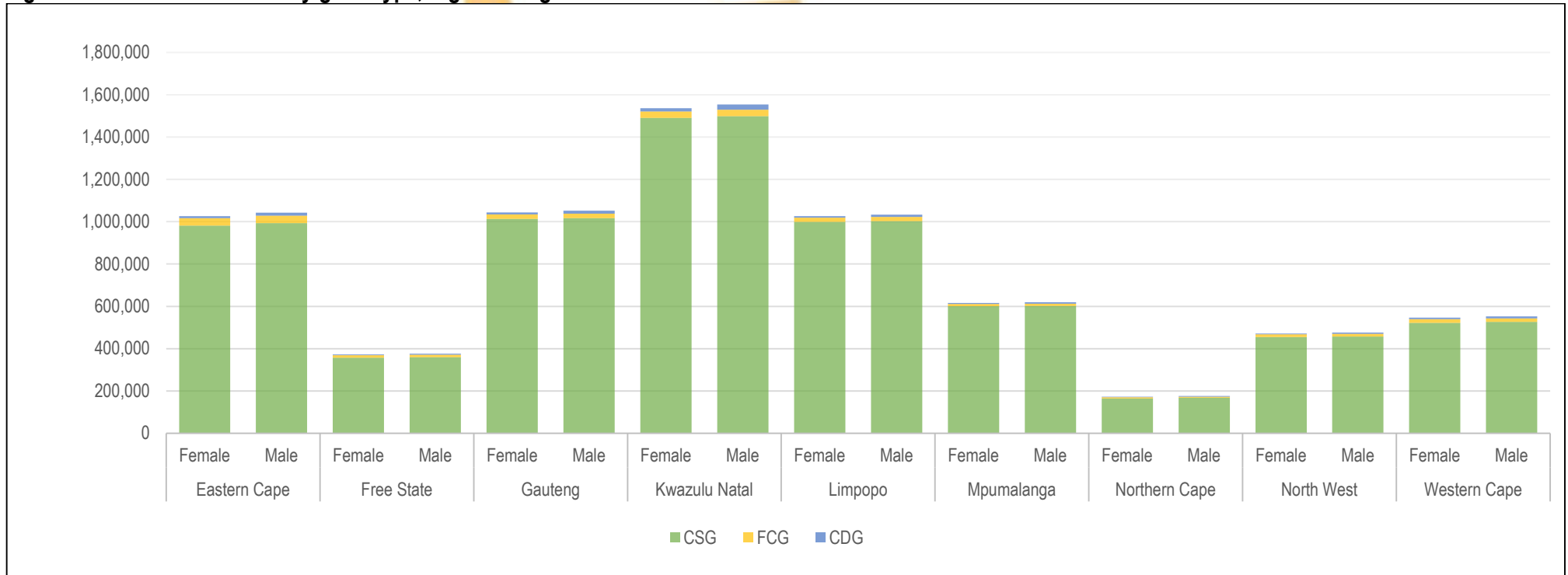

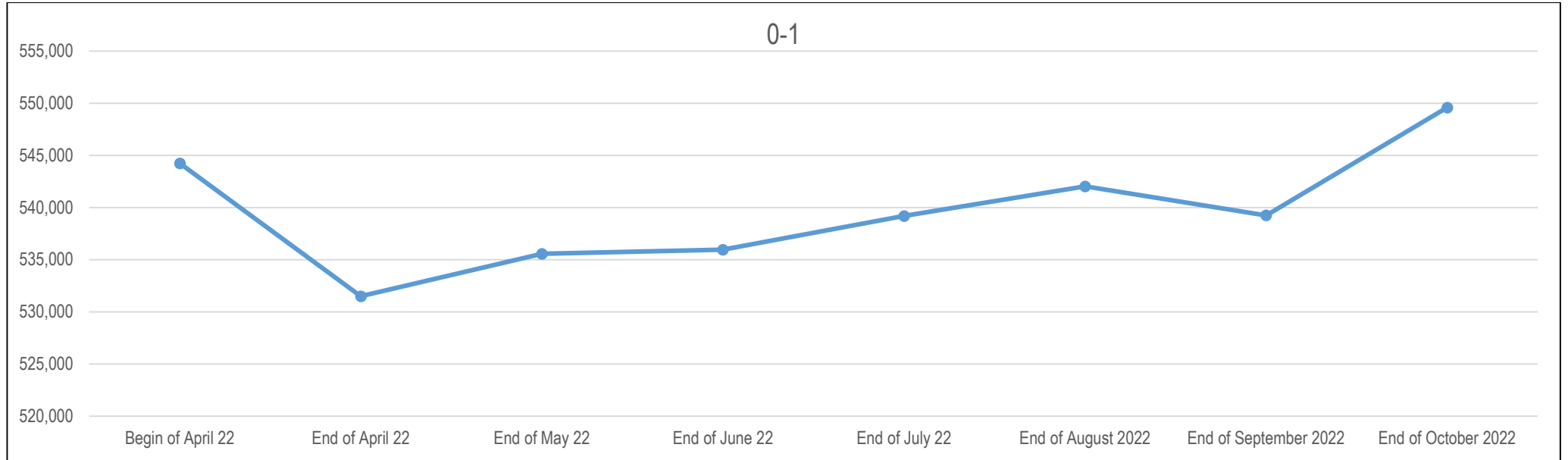
Figure 9: Number of children by grant type, region and gender

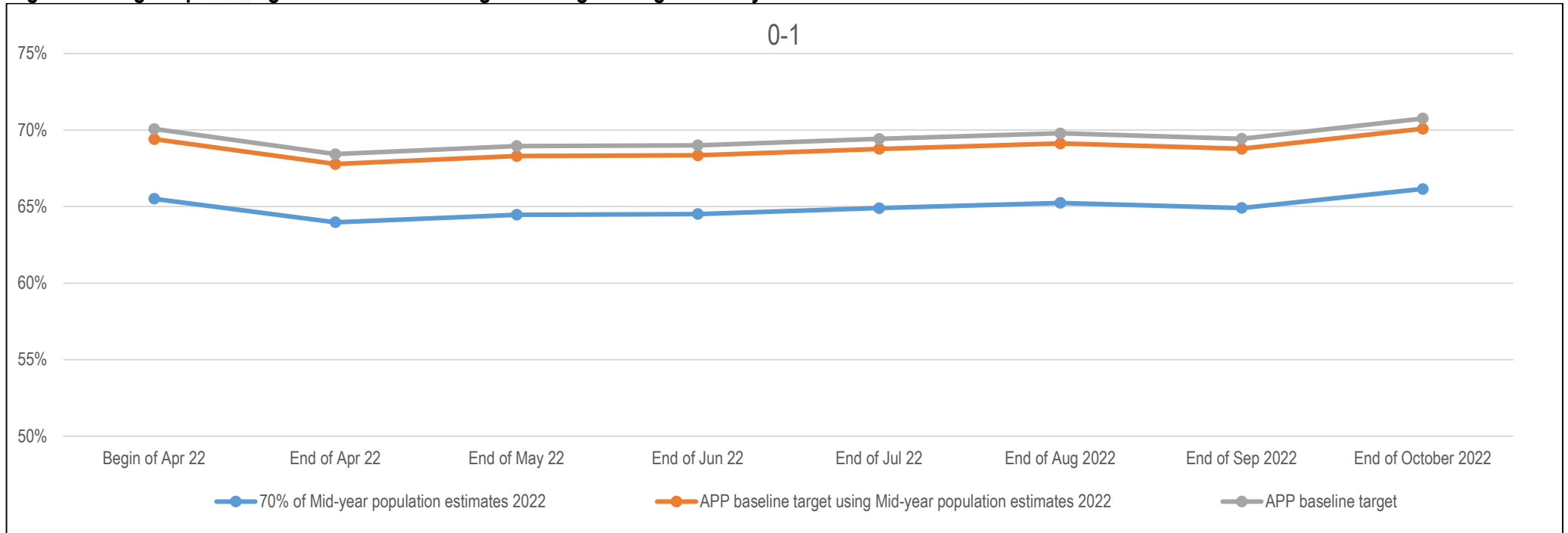

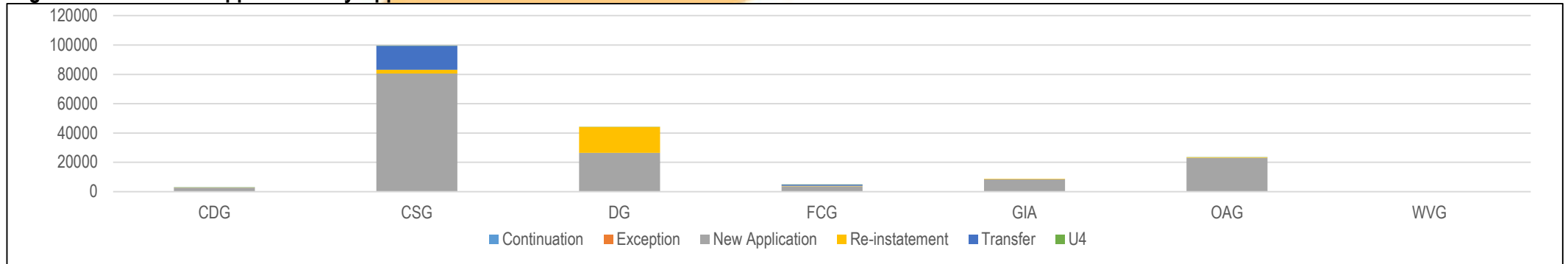

**Figure 12: Number of Applications by Application Status**

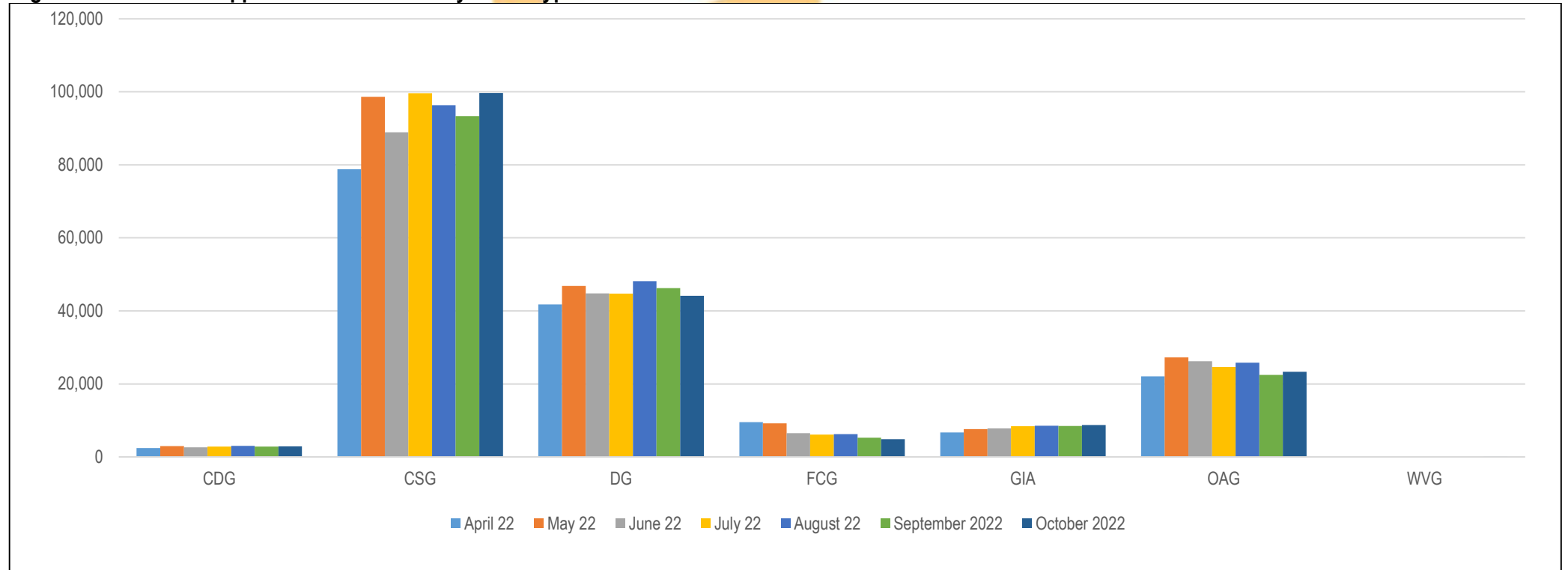

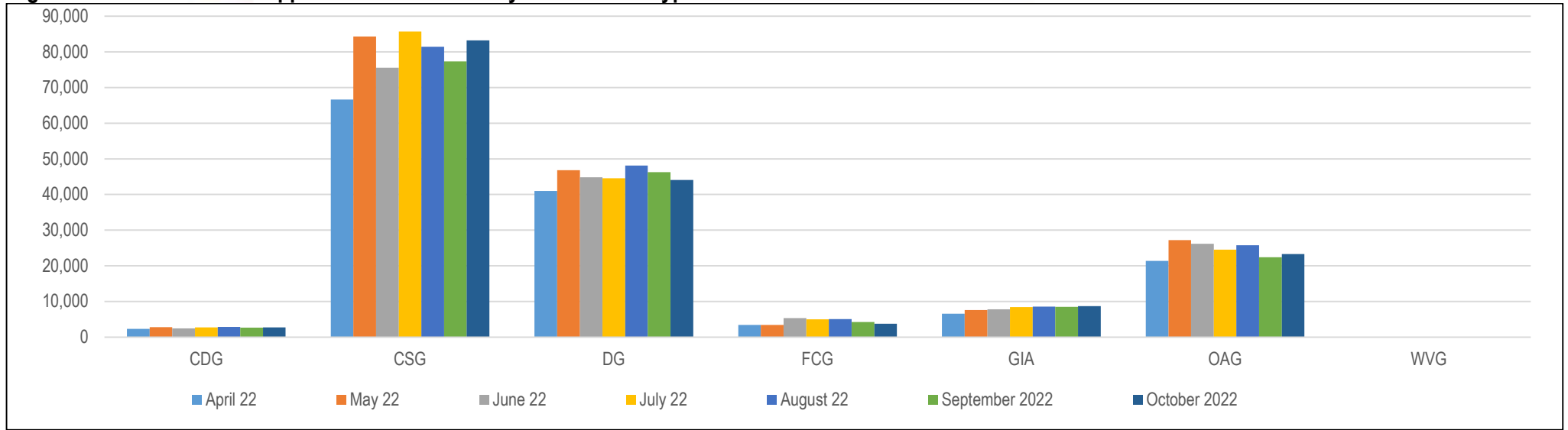

**Figure 14: Number of New Applications Processed by Social Grant Type**



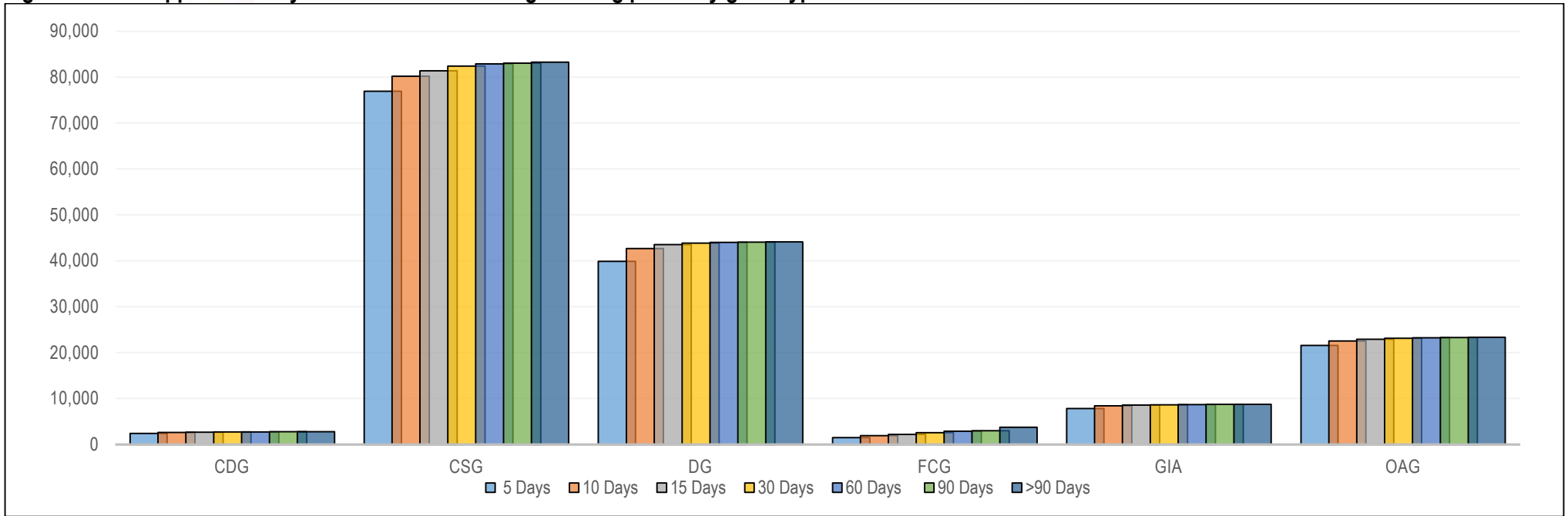

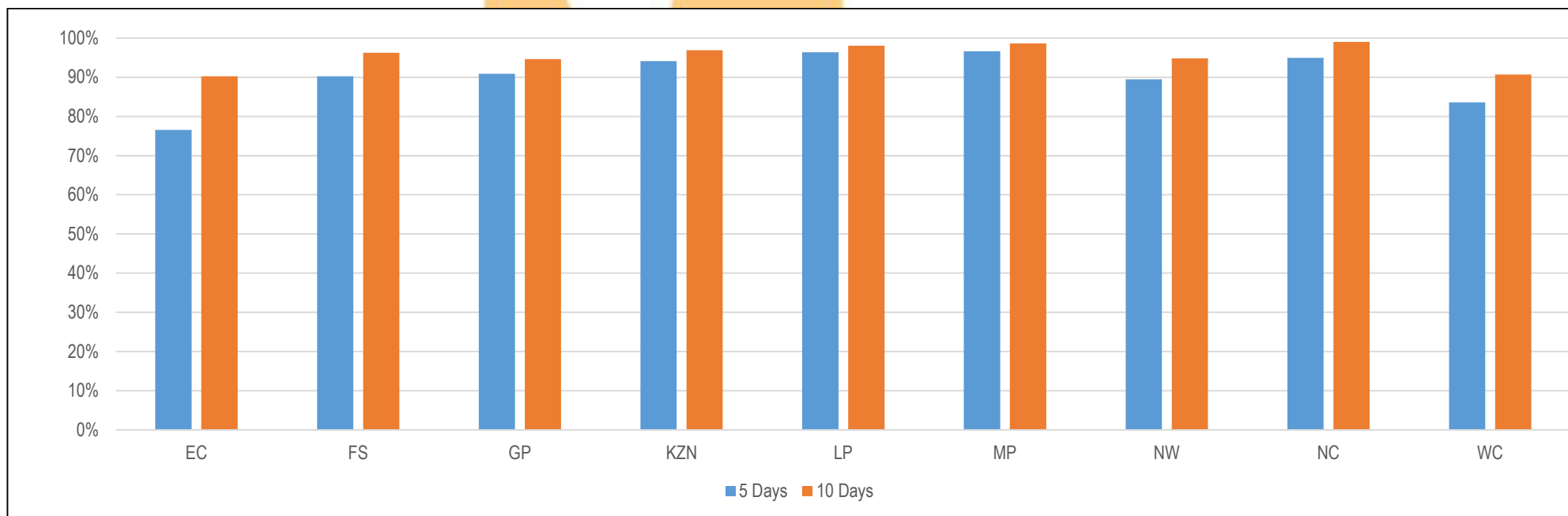

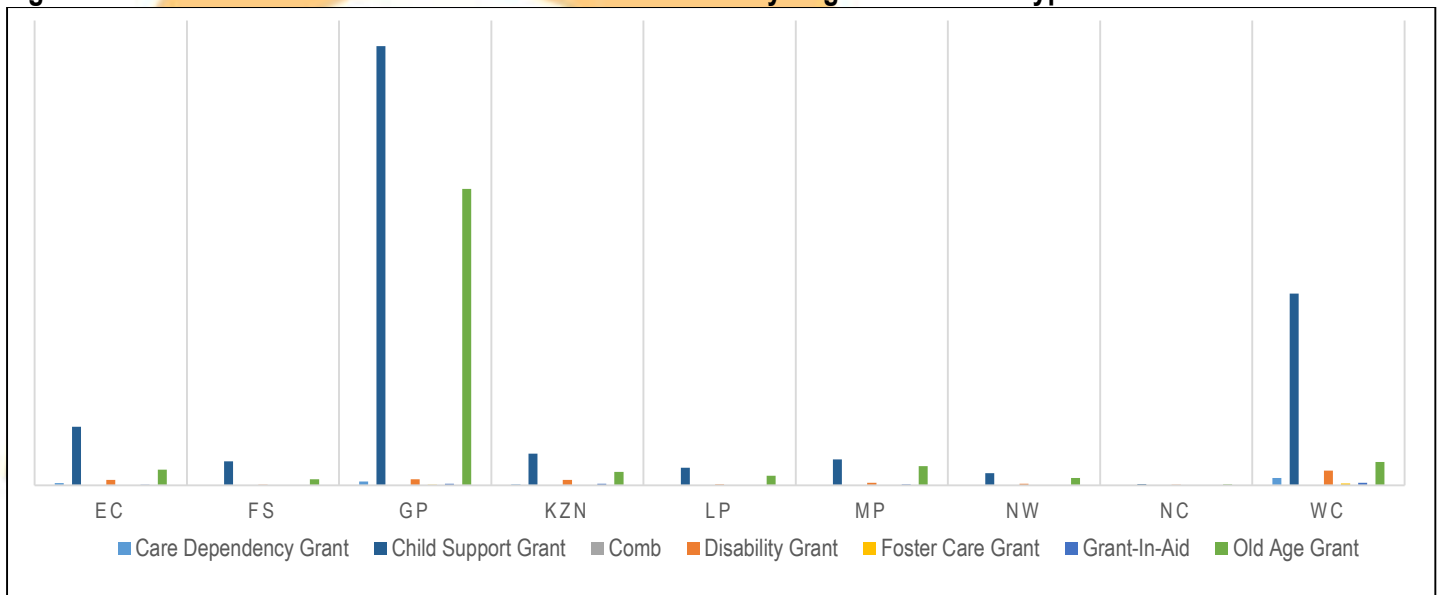

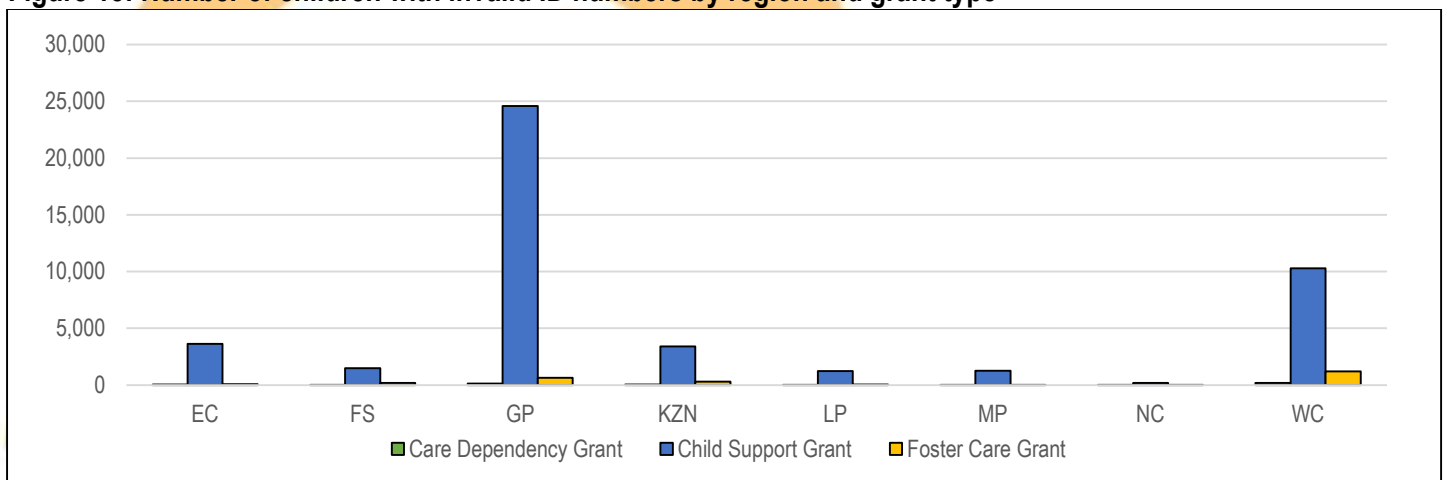

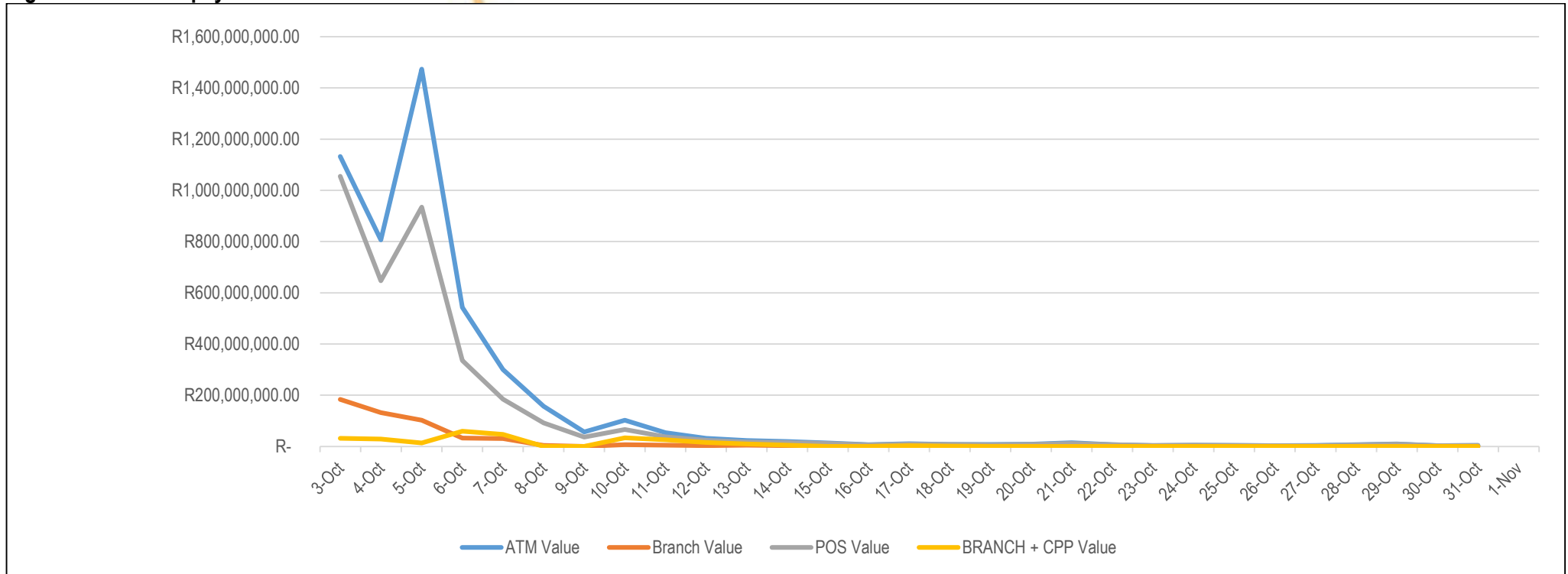

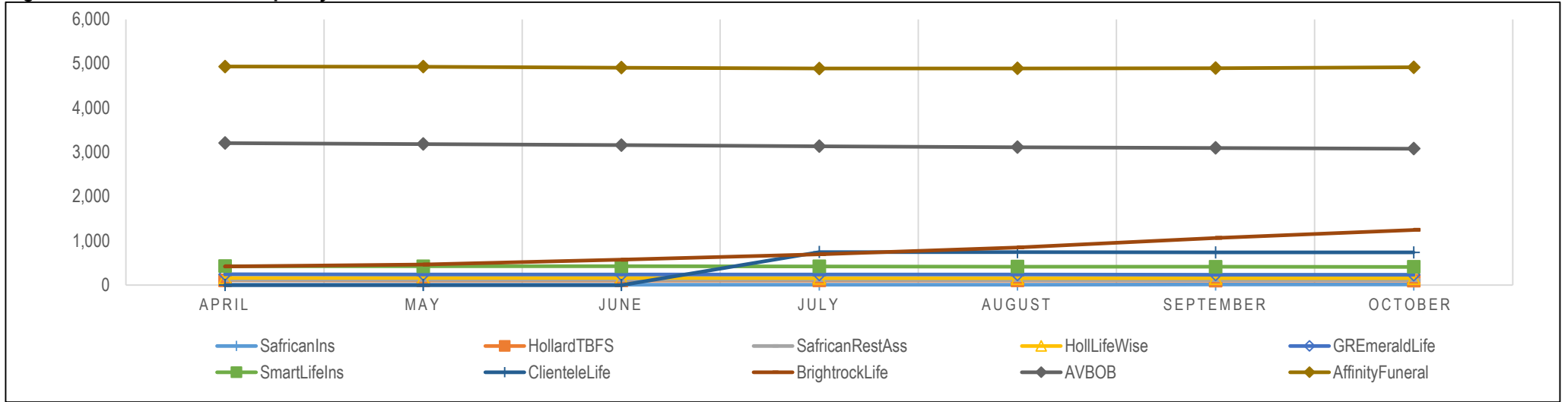

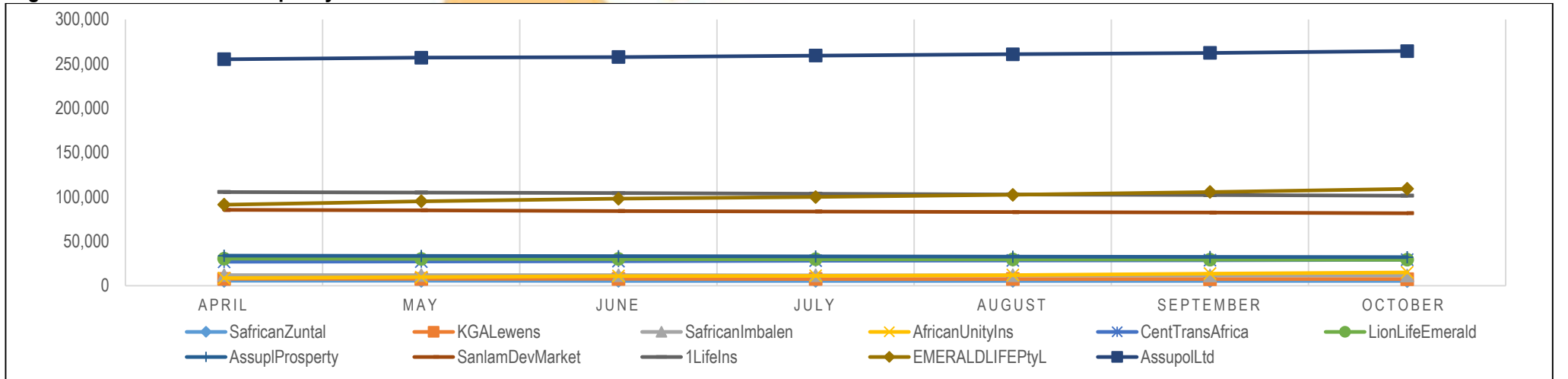
